




time, every one of our dealers will feel like part of the Kawai family."

"I can tell you that the Line 6 team is most excited about the merger because we found that both Yamaha and Line 6 share a very similar culture and a very similar overall business goal, and that is enriching the lives of people in the world and musicians through music," said Paul Foeckler, Line 6 president and CEO.

#### Jazz Saxophonist Bowen **Bebops for Vandoren**

Dansr presented some serious bebop at its booth on Thursday afternoon. During a demonstration intended to generate interest in Vandoren's newly expanded V16 metal tenor mouthpiece line, New York-based

saxophonist Ralph Bowen performed in a duo with bassist Mark Sorlie for an attentive crowd of retailers and jazz fans.

A longtime Vandoren endorser. Bowen said he currently plays a medium-chamber metal V16 that produces a focused sound reminiscent of the 1950s jazz scene. The new metal V16 line also includes a largechamber model that facilitates a broader sound with a 1940s jazz esthetic as well as a small-chamber model that's virtually identical to Vandoren's original metal

"This is an American-designed French mouthpiece that was created in collaboration

with U.S. artists like Ralph, and it's characteristic of a number of different sounds that are common in the jazz medium," said Michael Skinner, president of Dansr, which distributes Vandoren. "It's a very free-blowing mouthpiece cut from one piece of bell metal brass and finished in 24-karat gold.'

Unlike some of Vandoren's older mouthpiece designs, the revamped metal V16s have no baffle and noticeably less edge. "That's

gone now," said Skinner. "It's open and very dark, a beautiful round sound — as you can tell when you hear Ralph play."

Skinner pointed out that new metal V16 is competitively priced at \$499. "It not only



gives an opportunity for professional players," he said, "but a lot of high school kids now have their first opportunity to play a pro-quality tenor mouthpiece at a price they can actually afford."

Bowen, who also performed at Wednesday night's VandoJam, uses Vandoren Java Red #3 1/2 reeds and a Vandoren harness neckstrap. His V16 has a size 5 tip opening.

#### Casio Enters DJ Controller Market

Casio's new XW-J1 is the company's first foray into the DJ controller market.

"At this show, we are entering a completely new category with the XW-J1," said Mike Martin, general manager of marketing, at the Casio booth on Thursday. "The XW-J1 is for the DJ who is most likely spinning electronic dance music, and this product is



designed specifically to work with iPads and iOS devices. It uses an app called djay, the number-one DJ app in the iTunes store, and we have the best integration with that application in a piece of hardware.'

The XW-J1 has dedicated EQ controls and high-resolution touch-sensitive jog wheels.

"I've been amazed at how many people are interested in the XW-J1," added Stephen Schmidt, vice president. "We partnered with Vestax, which has been making DJ controllers for many years.'



#### Huckabee **Advocates School** Music at PMC

The Percussion Marketing Council's (PMC) annual all-member meeting yesterday included a keynote speech from former Arkansas governor Mike Huckabee. Board members discussed the council's programs and campaigns aimed at creating new players.

"I can sum up the PMC pretty simply: We want to make more players," said Brad Smith, senior sales and marketing manager for Hal Leonard. Smith and other board members detailed the PMC's outreach programs including Drums Across America, Percussion in the Schools, and Roots of Rhythm.

Huckabee, a bass player and advocate of arts and music education, emphasized that "music is a vital part of our culture," and should be part of the education experience for American children. "The arts in general and music specifically is not extra-curricular, it's not extraneous and it's most certainly not expendable," Huckabee said.

PMC also announced that International Drum Month will move from November to May to switch the campaign from the busy holiday season to the slower summer months.





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#### Line 6 Introduces Amplifi, Amp & App With Cloud Connection and Tone-Matching

Paul Foeckler, president and CEO of Line 6, introduced the company's new music playback and standalone amp, Amplifi, on Thursday.

Line 6 introduced its first digital modeling amp at The NAMM Show in 1996 and has sold over 1 million amps to guitarists.

Foeckler said Amplifi is inspired by the rise of smart devices. "The average per-

son today checks their smart device over 150 times a dav." said Foeckler. "Wow. Let's be honest: None of those things are nearly as fulfilling as listening to music and enjoying it by playing the guitar.'

Amplifi provides a new platform for guitarists to experience music. In addition to being a standalone guitar amp, users can wirelessly stream and jam along with tracks from any Bluetoothenabled device. The amp comes in 150and 75-watt versions and has a wide range of DSP effects.

The amp also matches a track's guitar tones. When users connect to the cloud with the Amplifi Remote app, they can rate tones and share them, adding a social element.

Max Gutnik, senior vice president of products and marketing at Line 6, demonstrated Amplifi by matching tones and playing along with AC/DC's "Back In Black" and The Eagles' "Life In The Fast Lane."

"Locked Out Of Heaven," Gutnik matched the guitar sound from The Police's "Roxanne," which has a similar tone, then saved it to his library.

"There are millions of songs out there; we'd like to see millions of tones matched to them," said Foeckler.

# Zoom Launches iQ5 Stereo Microphone for iOS Devices

Zoom has announced the iQ5 mid-side condenser microphone for the iPhone, iPad and iPod Touch.

The iQ5 attaches to the iOS device's Lightning connector and provides two microphone elements in a mid-side configuration.

The iQ5 can be used in either portrait or landscape mode and has a rotating mechanism that ensures correct left-right stereo orientation. It offers 16-bit, 44.1-kHz recording and provides an analog-type mic gain wheel for precision adjustment of input level, along with three auto gain presets, built-in limiting, an automatic recording function and a dedicated headphone jack.

The iQ5 works with any iPhone (5 or later), iPod Touch (5th generation or later), iPad (4th generation or later) or iPad mini (running iOS 6.0 or newer).

It can be used in conjunction with most iOS apps that support audio input from an external

microphone, including Camera, GarageBand and video streaming apps, as well as Zoom's free Handy Recorder app, which allows the width of the soundstage to be altered in post-production, as well as adding editing capabilities and effects such as compression, EQ and reverb.

"The iQ5 allows anyone to make great-sounding recordings on their smartphones and other iOS devices," said Eric Battin, product manager at Zoom. "It opens up a whole new world of possibilities for creators looking to add high-quality audio to their videos."

#### **GERSON ROSENBLOOM**

Chicago | 1964

The place was the Conrad Hilton Hotel. My dad was premiering Elger U.S.-Made Guitars (a precursor to what eventually became Ibanez), and I was a starry-eyed teenager walking from one hotel room to the next (that's where the exhibits were in those days) meeting musical heroes like Johnny Smith, Art Van Damme, Buddy Rich and Buddy

DeFranco. There are enough memories from

that show to fill a book (or at least a good solid article!). One that stands out was joining my dad in a meeting with Henry Grossman (founder of Grossman Music, Trophy/ Grover/Rogers) striking a distribution deal for our guitars

Easy Music Cente Anaheim I 2006

I was a brand new retailer, experiencing my first taste of success as a business owner. On the first night, after a long day of meetings, we took a trip into Los Angeles to go to the Viper room to see Paul Gilbert play. I was really fired up to be at NAMM, to be part of something bigger than just my small store, and to be at a Paul Gilbert show. And I guess I still hadn't really learned my lesson with alcohol. About halfway through the show I started yelling at the top of my lungs for Paul Gilbert to play "Terrible Man." Again and





ease of response. Its slightly more open tip and subtle interior changes provide a different color in the saxophonist's palette.

"When the AL3 was introduced, it quickly became the go-to mouthpiece for alto saxophonists and band directors around the world," offered Andy Blanco, Vandoren brand manager for DANSR Inc. "The AL5 builds on that success, combining what players love about the AL3 with a little added projection and tone color."

James Bunte of the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music added "I am honestly going to be recommending that my students check out the AL5. It seems to have that great dark core that the AL3 has, but the slightly wider tip opening makes it more dynamic, and able to take more air."







After experimenting with blending heavier medium gauge strings for the top three (treble) strings with the bass strings of the regular light set, Fogleman said that they found that the optimum gauging for the HD Light set to be .013, .017, .025, .032, .042 and .053.

"The new HD Light sets are perfect for these narrow-body style guitars," Powers adds. "The hand feel is incredibly balanced. Knowing that I was going to get to use this string set actually influenced the way I braced and voiced the guitars, because I knew that they would create a unique tension profile.'
