

"We want to build better guitars and do a better job than we've ever done," Powers said. "Some of the same improvements you saw in the 800 Series went into this guitar — the super-thin finish, essentially a philosophy of making everything as good as it can be. So each of the designs ends up with its own unique bracing pattern. And the right thicknesses and the right glues and putting

everything together to maximize that. What makes it even better is that this is a practical step in a longer, more forward-thinking outlook.

That outlook involves finding sustainable wood sources. During the dinner, company founder Bob Taylor interviewed Steve Mc-Minn, the founder and owner of Pacific Rim Tonewoods. McMinn and Taylor discussed a recent study into cloning and growing wood for guitars.

"Steve and I have formed a company in Hawaii because we have tropics on U.S. soil," Taylor said. "We're starting to grow and improve koa. We also know we can grow American mahogany there, Cuban mahogany, Honduras mahogany. We've started a research project to see if can we grow ebony."

The POP also includes the visual merchandise behind the guitars along with images of Fender artists along the top.

In response to Fender's recent decision to start selling direct to consumers on its website, Farrell said the company is trying to overextend what it is doing when it comes to pointing consumers in the right direction.

"If someone goes to fender.com and decides they want to purchase a guitar, there are dealer locaters everywhere that will point them in the direction of the closest local dealer first," he said.

Also at the show, Fender is debuting its "10 For '15" Limited Edition Collection which serves like a guitar of the month program running from March-December 2015. The collection will include a different, unique model each month with availability limited to 500 models. Dealers must opt into the program in order to be able to snatch up the guitars.

"[The collection] is great for us because if we were to offer a Shell Pink model and they were to be snatched up fast, then we know that's what people are looking for," Farrell said.

Acoustics Power Guitar Market

During a panel discussion on the state of the guitar market at Wednesday's Guitar and Accessories Manufacturers Association (GAMA) meeting, one thing was clear: acoustic stringed instruments are still driving the market. The panel was moderated by Paul Majeski, publisher of Music Trades magazine. Here are some views from four top executives:



Bob Taylor, co-founder, Taylor Guitars

Acoustic guitars are quite popular. We're making a record number of guitars. More than we've ever made. More than I've ever dreamed.



Jim D'Addario, CEO, D'Addario & Co.

One of the things that we have as a barometer at D'Addario is that we do quite a bit of business supplying you folks who make guitars with strings. So, we get to see a weather vane of where things are going. There's some pretty good optimism out there and quite a few orders on the books, which is great.



Steve Long, CEO, Long & McQuade

Ukuleles are still quite hot, obviously. They were hot for quite a few years, and everyone thought it was going to peak. But standing in some of our stores over Christmas, in spite of the fact that we bought tons of ukuleles, on Boxing Day, we were saying, 'Well, we don't have any ukuleles in stock right now.' That was above expectations.

Mike Doyle, senior vice president of guitar merchandising, Guitar Center

We sold around 1.3 million guitars last year across the Guitar Center enterprise. And I agree with the panel that the acoustic guitar business has been a significant driver of that — acoustic stringed instruments and ukuleles. Lately, we have seen somewhat of a resurgence in the electric guitar business, too.

This year, Amptweaker decided to offer a limited run of only 49 pedals using these lower output germaniums, and the BluesFuzz was born.

Why a limited edition of 49? Some fans believe that the famous crossroads where Robert Johnson supposedly dealt with the devil was Highway 49 and 61 in Clarksdale,

Amptweaker's James and Phyllis Brown both grew up along Highway 49 and first met in a truck stop poolroom on that highway. Many people from Mississippi are influenced by the blues, which is evident in James' playing, so this is a tip of the hat to the Browns' personal connection with the blues.

The pedal excels in getting clean tones, thanks to the auto-bias built into the Fuzzcontrol. It also includes the Boost Switch MOD, which boosts the gain about 10dB, so players can get more fuzz or help compensate for lower output vintage pickups.

Other standard Amptweaker features include the proprietary Tight control, magnetic battery door and a built-in effects loop with pre/post switch that tracks the pedal's bypass switch for simple one-click tones.
