

PMC Members Express Passion for Drums

The Percussion Marketing Council (PMC) held its annual all-membership meeting at the Hilton yesterday morning, highlighted by a roundtable discussion with leaders from retail and manufacturing.

The roundtable participants were Randy Pratt (Musician's Friend), Jim Rupp (Columbus Percussion), Rob Andre (Chicago Drum Exchange), Shane Kinney (Drum Center of Portsmouth), Remo Belli (Remo Inc.), Don Lombardi (Drum Workshop), Andy Zildjian (Sabian Ltd.) and Alan Vater (Vater Percussion).

The discussion was moderated by Kevin Kearns of *Modern Drummer*, who asked each leader to comment on the current state of the industry and predict what the industry will look like five years from now.

A theme throughout the conversation

was the intense level of passion that manufacturers, dealers and customers have for playing a drum set.

Kinney, whose store is based in New Hampshire, offered a retailer's perspective.

"When people come in [to my store], their eyes light up when they think about drums or drumming," he said. "It really doesn't matter what's popular — there seems to be a large amount of people who want to play drums and have an enthusiasm for drums. Part of the problem is inexpensive electronic drums that don't allow a student to really learn; it creates frustration, and they just give up."

Karl Dustman, co-executive director of the PMC, brought members up to date on various educational initiatives, including Roots of Rhythm and Percussion in the Schools. **PMC (playdrums.com)**

"We gave the CSVR to each one of these players on stage," said Abair during a pre-performance speech. "We told them once they tested the instrument they could go back to using their original clarinets, and every single one of them said they wanted to use the CSVR tonight."

"We come across countless sounds daily that our minds consciously or subconsciously acknowledge. If you take the bus to work every morning, the sounds of that bus may evoke a reoccurring mood. Associative Music samples these sounds, disguising them in melodies and rhythms in hopes of provoking a visceral reaction."

GO BEYOND INSTRUMENTS

"I can make drums or a keyboard patch out of literally any sound in the world. I made huge kick drums out of a rat's heartbeat, a snare drum out of the sound of me being painfully electrocuted, and an 808-type sub-bass from the guttural humming of an 86-year old, fully tattooed man."

DEFY CATEGORIZATION

"Producer or musician? There's no distinction. When you take a snake and let it slither over a harp, is the snake the musician or is it the instrument and you're the musician? When you take that cacophonous, atonal recording of that snake on a harp and process it into something unrecognizable from the original, are you just a producer?"

DESTROY CREATIVELY

"I run a lot of equipment through cheap boomboxes instead of amps since they were never really meant for that, and I like hearing equipment struggle. I've used a lot of bizarre equipment and recording procedures. Like microwaving cassette tapes after recording stuff to them."

The Fender Custom Shop has unveiled Senior Master Builder Yuriy Shishkov's latest masterpiece: the handcrafted "Pine Cone Stratocaster" guitar modeled after



the antique "Pine Cone" Easter Egg made by Fabergé in 1900. This one-of-a-kind guitar features 550 high-quality diamonds, 10 feet of fine silver, and 18-karat gold adorning a flawless single-piece maple body and exhibition-grade bird's eye maple neck.

The body artwork design was created in a 3D format and projected onto the guitar before it was hand-carved to produce the sphere surface effect of an egg.



If all the scales on the guitar were extended beyond the instrument's contour, they would create a perfect "egg" shape. The blue hand-stained "multi-composite" finish was specially invented for this particular guitar to recreate the "egglike" appearance. The guitar's hardware was hand-engraved; the knobs and switch tip were custom designed at the Fender Custom Shop and crowned with diamonds. In addition, the Fender logo on the headstock is made of 2 mm solid silver and 18-karat gold-plated metal. The fingerboard comes complete with inlaid diamonds and gold-plated gilding and is finished with a gold-plated nut.

The "old stock" pickups were handwound by legendary Fender Custom Shop pickup winder Abigail Ybarra and feature "encapsulated" pickup mounting, a never-before-seen technique that eliminates additional routing and leaves more "real estate" surface on the guitar's body for additional artwork.
