



THE HANDS

"I like to keep my grip fluid...not too loose, not too stiff. My hands open and close depending on how hard I'm playing, but I never grip the drumsticks tightly. I use matched grip for power and traditional grip on lighter, jazzier stuff."

THE RIGHT FOOT

"I teach flat-footed bass drum technique...it's kind of old school. Once you get past the couple years of pain, it makes you a stronger drummer. I always focus with the bass drum on the beat — not in front or back —

exactly on the beat, no matter what. I believe you need to set the standard of where the time is in each song."

THE CONFIDENCE

"When I was younger and famous people were coming into the clubs, we'd get all antsy and overplay. I found out the hard way to just be yourself, be relaxed, and have confidence. I always had chops, even as a kid. Now that I'm in my middle years, I let it flow — like painting with oils, an actual physical art — and always think about being musical."

THE SONG

"Play the song. It's not just playing the drums, but listening and then playing the song. Pick up all you can on your first listen and apply that to your interpretation. Add your own style without damaging the integrity of the music."

THE GROOVE

"Groove is obviously my signature – while other people try to conjure a groove and think about it – I find the key is not to think about it. If you think about playing a groove you're not gonna sound good. Stay in a relaxed state. I lean into it. I sway with it, like dancing. It's all about the groove."

GAMA's Optimism Shines

The Guitar and Accessories Marketing Association (GAMA) kicked off its annual meeting on Wednesday morning, recapping a successful year in 2015 and renewing its sense of optimism for the year to come.

Joe Lamond, NAMM president and CEO, opened the meeting with a bright outlook in light of recent legislation. "The passing of the Every Student Succeeds Act by Congress last month, and the signing of it by President Obama before Christmas, is going to change what you're doing," Lamond said to GAMA members. "Schools will have more access to guitar programs than ever before. Local control [will let] people decide in their own communities what kind of music education they want. The door is opening. This is the time to put your foot on the gas."

Moderator and GAMA President Peter D'Addario started the meeting with the announcement of two new board members, Yamaha's Dennis Webster and Fishman's Rob Ketch.

Allegra Hale provided a summary of the programs that received grants from GAMA in 2015, including Guitars For Vets, Make Music New York, Tilted Axes, Day Of Guitar and Lead Guitar. Together with Guitars in the Classroom (GITC), these programs received just



over one-half of the funding allotted for grants in 2015, which, D'Addario noted, opens the discussion for ramping up funding for any of these programs in the coming year, or adding more programs that are eligible to receive grants.

Additionally, Robert Sulkow, executive director of GAMA, gave a rundown of a profitable year for Teaching Guitar Workshops (TGW), the profit from which will be reinvested into the program for 2016.

"[TGW] trains more than 4,000 school music educators to bring guitar instruction to well over 1 million kids," Sulkow said. "This is the time to strike. This is the time to get more guitar programs in schools. It's a no-brainer and it's an easy addition to the music curriculum."
