

Schecter Goes 'Wylde' for Guitars

Zakk Wylde held a press conference Friday night at the Schecter booth to announce the release of his new line of Wylde Audio guitars. The guitars will be available exclusively at Guitar Center in the United States and will be distributed internationally by Schecter Guitars.

"Coming from being a 14-year-old kid in Jackson, New Jersey, practicing at my parents house and having all the posters on the walls of all my guys, [now] I'm actually with the companies that all my heroes played with," Wylde said. "I'm blessed that I get to have a signature guitar or a signature amp, and I couldn't ask for anything more. But it's like Michael Jordan: He was a player, then after that he went to coaching, then the VP, then the general manager. The next logical step is team owner. [Starting Wylde Audio] was the next logical step."

All of the guitars were designed by Wylde himself, with the help of John Gaudesi, master builder for Schecter. The first three Wylde Audio models — Viking, War Hammer and Odin — will be available this year, with three more designs currently in the works.

"Zakk's ultimate goal was, he wanted something that hit his working class audience. It was something that was going to be affordable," said Michael Ciravolo, president of Schecter. "I think we achieved that."

"At the end of the day, as long as you're making something that kicks ass, that's all that matters," Wylde said.
