





Faith Delivers Patrick James Eggle Legacy Series

Voted the United Kingdom's best acoustic guitar for six years and counting, Faith guitars is known for solid wood guitars with a superior fit and finish at a good price.

Faith looks to add to that reputation with the PJE Legacy guitar line, delivering professional guitars at a

\$1,500 price point. PJE Legacy Series guitars have a rich, warm and mature sound that usually takes 20-plus years to achieve. The instrument's Canadian Sitka spruce tops have been kiln-aged through the process of torrefaction. In basic terms, the spruce is air dried before being roasted in a kiln with precise controls over atmospheric and oxygen levels to reduce its moisture content. Then as the wood cools, precise amounts of moisture are reintroduced to the wood.

This process produces a rich, golden color that radiates an authentic vibe. Like all Faith guitars, the PJE Legacy Series are solid wood — fine, torrefied Canadian Sitka spruce for the top and figured African Khava mahogany for the back and sides.

The pickup system is Fishman's latest "Flex-T-Blend," which combines the crispness of a piezo undersaddle pickup with the characteristic tones of an internal condenser mic. The controls are discreet and don't distract from the guitar's contour.

Yamaha Infuses TransAcoustic Into FG, FS

Yamaha is showcasing the FG Trans-Acoustic — two guitars that combine the durability and affordability of the FG and FS series instruments with Yamaha's TransAcoustic technology.

The FG-TA dreadnought and its concert-size counterpart, the FS-TA, are built on the design of the company's FG820 and FS820 models.

TransAcoustic Technology enhances the playability of the guitars by employing an integrated actuator, a small metal device completely hidden inside the guitar that represents a new concept in acoustic guitar technology.

When the instrument's strings are played, they cause the actuator to vibrate, which is then conveyed to the guitar body and the air around the guitar. This movement creates authentic reverb and chorus effects without needing any external amplification or effects.

TransAcoustic guitar technology was first introduced in 2016 in the premium Yamaha LL-TA and LS-TA TransAcoustic models, which earned Best in Show honors at Summer NAMM as well as a Best of What's New distinction from *Popular Science* magazine.

The Riversong Magagna Signature guitar model has been named after David Magagna, Riversong's sales manager.

The first run of Magagna Signature guitars was a success, leading to a second run. The Magagna Signature employs Riversong's Double Reaction Bridge and Skeletized Bracing technologies.

In 2012, Riversong introduced its neck-through design that gives a greater resonance, superior adjustability and strong overall playing experience.

In 2017, in a collaboration with Philip Shaheen, an oud builder from the Middle East, Mike Miltimore, founder of Riversong Guitars, designed and developed a Stage oud, based on the Stage guitar. They also worked on a guitar bridge based on the oud bridge design. The result is the Double Reaction Bridge, which gives an additional 10 percent volume gain over conventional alued-on bridges.

Miltimore also developed a bracing system while experimenting with moving mass around on the guitar top. The result is Riversong's Skeletized Bracing, geared to improve the vibration resonant quality without sacrificing structural quality. Riversong Guitars (riversongguitars.com)
